■ PB = Poster Blitz

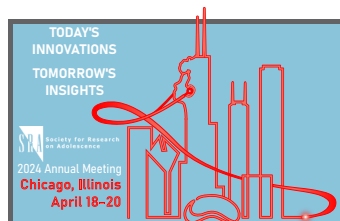
A group of 10 posters presented orally for 5 minutes each. Presenters stand in front of their posters while they orally present.
